Answers to frequently asked questions:

Where will the rally be held?

The Rally will be held at Burke County High School on March 24, 2012.

Where can I buy the kit to build an E-MTV?*

The electric vehicle (E-MTV) can be purchased from [Luis Romo at EV Master](#). It includes all of the parts needed to construct and wire an E-MTV.

What tools do I need?

What vehicles are allowed to compete in the rally?

The annual EV Rally is open to full sized electric vehicles, electric racing go carts and E-MTVs. We will also have an innovation class for other alternative fuel vehicles: solar, electric hybrids, biofuels, etc.

What is the cost of participation in the Rally?

Registration fees for the 2012 EV Rally will be \$50 per school and \$10 per student. Each team member and sponsor will receive an EV hat or T-Shirt.

What is the program schedule for the Rally?

The EV Rally consists of one exciting day with three driving and three academic events. Students will test their driving skills and the design of their vehicle in acceleration, autocross and range competitions. They will also demonstrate their knowledge and expertise in Troubleshooting, Oral Presentation and Science Quiz Bowl. Details on the rules and regulations for the rally are posted on evclubsouth.org

Are prizes and/or trophies awarded?
